Round 6 has completed in the Junior Competition for both boys and girls in POM.

For the Under 13 boys competition, Defence Green and Idubada Tigers are the early frontrunners dominating the competition. Under 15 boys sees Defence out in front with a perfect season so far, followed by Kelu

Bombers and Gordons Kokofas. Whilst the Under 17 boys competition is led by Defence and De La Selle (The AFLPNG Academy side).

For the girls competition, the Idubada Tigers lead the Under 13s and 15s Competitions. Whilst in the Open comp the Kelu Bombers are the early leaders.

The Regional Championships will commence throughout PNG in July. The best young players will play in the knockout style championships with the opportunity to be selected to represent their regions.
